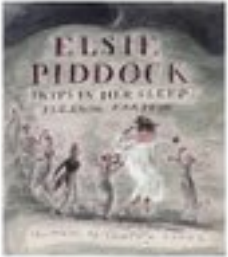


Elsie Piddock
